STUDENT RECORDS





Student records for the majority of the alumni of **Westminster College** (the Methodist teacher training college founded in 1851) have been deposited in the College archive held by the Oxford Centre for Methodism and Church History at Oxford Brookes University (with whom Westminster College merged in 2000). The contents and extent of these records varies depending on when the student was at the College.

Student Registers

The registers of teachers trained by the Wesleyan Education Committee at both Westminster and Southlands Colleges between 1861 and 1922 have been digitised, and are in the process of being uploaded to the **Centre's Digital Collections page**. As such, these volumes are freely accessible to all.

Student Record Cards

The record cards for students at Westminster College between 1922 and 1972 are sorted alphabetically, and information can be provided upon request. The record cards from 1972 through to the College's merger in 2000 are currently unsorted.

Other Records

For students at the College between 1942 and 1962, the College produced testimonials, which are in bound volumes in the College archive. Copies of testimonials are available upon request. The archives also include pass lists for students at the College between 1932 and 1979, and other miscellaneous records which vary by student and depend heavily upon individual donations to the archive.

College Transcripts

The Centre is unable to provide transcripts relating to study at Westminster College as we hold little material relating to course marks or course descriptions.
